ARTS, ENTERTAINMENT, AND MEDIA BUSINESS, BA

The Bachelor of Arts in Arts, Entertainment, and Media Business is a liberal arts degree designed for the student who has an interest in the general study of performing arts disciplines, such as music and theatre, across a range of traditions and genres, but with a particular eye toward the business operations of these areas. The degree is crafted to provide foundational skills in business, foundational skills in the performing arts, and then elective through which students can specialize further in both their business and artistic preferences.

Auditions for music lessons and/or ensembles and theatre productions conform to the requirements and processes of CCPA's three conservatories, and occur after the student has matriculated and at a point appropriate in degree progress, in consultation with the student's advisor.

At least 12 credits must be at the 300-level. No more than 12 credit hours at the 100-level may be counted toward the major. At least 15 credit hours in the major must be taken at Roosevelt.

Grade Requirements:

Students must maintain an overall grade point average of 2.0 or higher in the major. Grades of C- or higher are required in all CCPA 300-level courses.
