

PERFORMANCE DIPLOMA IN CLASSICAL GUITAR, PED

Offered in: Roosevelt Online and Chicago

The Online Performance Diploma in Classical Guitar will be offered beginning in the Fall 2023 semester.

The Performance Diploma in Classical Guitar is a two-year post-baccalaureate certificate program designed for the accomplished instrumentalist who wishes to continue performance studies at an advanced level. The remote/online modality is open only to students majoring in classical guitar.

The program's objectives are to provide an intensive period of performance study and to allow students to concentrate on repertoires and genres of their choice (solo, solo/orchestral, or chamber music).

All repertory for study and performance is at the discretion of the major teacher. Two full recitals will be given, one at the end of each year.
