FINANCE, MINOR (FOR NON-BUSINESS MAJORS)

The Finance minor for non-business majors provides students with basic coursework in Finance. Courses include; Money & Banking: Principles of Finance; Corporate Finance or Investments, one 300-level elective course in Finance and basic Business courses including Principles of Accounting I and Principles of Economics I & II.

Requirements

A non-Business student who wishes to take a Finance minor must take seven classes total. At least four of the courses must be taken at Roosevelt University, and all courses must be passed with grades of Cor higher with an average of at least 2.0. Students must complete all prerequisites for courses in their chosen minor area.

The Finance minor is highly compatible with the following majors: All majors within the Heller College of Business, Actuarial Science, Data Analytics, Economics, Mathematics, Real Estate.
