The CCPA woodwinds, brass, and percussion programs prepare students for careers as solo, chamber music, and large ensemble performers, while instilling habits consistent with success in the professional environment.

The programs' objectives are to:

- Develop performative capabilities, addressing technical proficiency, knowledge of history and practice specific to their instrument family, and broad awareness of musical styles and repertory;
- Develop musicianship through a comprehensive curriculum of written and aural skills, conducting, analysis, history, and literature;
- Train effective musical collaboration through guided experiences in large and small ensemble performances, studying music of all periods and genres (including new music and opera);
- Balance the skills-focused music curriculum with a wide choice of academic electives;
- Acclimate students to the entrepreneurial challenges and opportunities of a music career.

B- is the minimum passing grade for PERF 313 JUNIOR RECITAL and PERF 314 SENIOR RECITAL.

Juries (Woodwind)

B- is the minimum passing grade for PERF 261 FRESHMAN JURY and the first semester of PERF 262 SOPHOMORE JURY.

B- is the minimum passing grade for the second semester of PERF 262 SOPHOMORE JURY, PERF 361 JUNIOR JURY, and PERF 362 SENIOR JURY.

Juries (Brass & Percussion)

Recital Repertoire

PERF 313 JUNIOR RECITAL

Woodwinds & Brass: 30 minutes of music is required. Students are required to share recitals with other juniors. A maximum of 10 minutes of chamber music may be included. The recital will be graded by the applied instructor.

Percussion: All recital repertory requirements are at the discretion of the applied instructor. Recitals are graded by the Program Director and one other faculty member.

All recitals must include 60 minutes of music, to be divided among marimba/vibraphone/xylophone, timpani and multi percussion/advanced snare drum solo suite.

PERF 314 SENIOR RECITAL

Woodwinds & Brass: 45 minutes of music is required (with intermission, the recital should last approximately one hour). A maximum of 15 minutes of chamber music may be included. The recital will be graded by the applied instructor and at least one other faculty member.

Percussion: All recital repertory requirements are at the discretion of the applied instructor. Recitals are graded by the Program Director and one other faculty member.

All recitals must include 60 minutes of music, to be divided among marimba/vibraphone/xylophone, timpani and multi percussion/advanced snare drum solo suite.

Jury Repertoire

Woodwind & Brass

Students are strongly encouraged (and some may be required by their applied professors) to perform solo literature from memory. All repertoire must be approved by the applied professor.

- Undergraduate students at the freshman and sophomore levels will prepare 10 minutes of music for the solo jury.
- Undergraduate students at the junior and senior levels will prepare 15 minutes of music for the solo jury.

Percussion

All jury requirements are at the discretion of the applied professor.
